Your centre may also offer facilitated groups to help with stress, including mindfulness-based stress reduction, relaxation and stress management, and therapeutic touch.

The Prince George Centre has an Indigenous Cancer Care Counsellor who can discuss transportation options to and from appointments, review options for accommodation, explore financial resources, attend appointments at the centre with patient and family members, advocate in the health care setting, discuss spiritual and cultural care needs, provide counselling support, and assist with transitions in care and return to community.
